### 1. The question of \_\_\_\_\_.

*If God is for us, who can be against us? (Rom. 8:31 NIV)*

*Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Even if she could forget... I will not forget you. (Is.49:15 NIV)*

### 2. The question of \_\_\_\_\_.

*He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things? (Rom. 8:32 NIV)*

*He has put his angels in charge of you to watch over you wherever you go. (Ps. 91:11 NCV)*

### 3. Two questions about \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

*Who can accuse the people God has chosen? No one, because God is the One who makes them right. Who can say God's people are guilty? No one, because Christ Jesus died, but he was also raised from the dead, and now he is on God's right side, appealing to God for us." (Rom. 8:33–34 NCV)*

*The Lord God helps me, so I will not be ashamed. I will be determined, and I know I will not be disgraced. He shows that I am innocent, and he is close to me. So who can accuse me? If there is someone, let us go to court together. If someone wants to prove I have done wrong, he should come and tell me. (Is. 50:7-8 NCV)*
