### MISSION PARTNERS

OHC short term mission teams partner with missionaries Matt and Leslie Capehart, and Maritza Jerez of Missions Frontier. We will construct village homes for Quiche widows and families who are unable to afford such a home. The team will also share the hope of Jesus to children and adults through Bible drama, praise, crafts, and activities. Another major area of service is the dental outreach ministry to villages, as well as the reading glass ministry.

### TRIP DETAILS

**Lodging:** Casa Del Rey is a hotel located on the mountainside overlooking the city of Chichicastenango. Each room is double or triple occupancy with a large area room with a fireplace and sitting room. The hotel has showers, with hot water, and bathroom facilities included in each room.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip cost. Dinner is buffet-style, including soup, salad, main course, and dessert.

**Trip Orientation:** We will have several Team Meetings prior to our trip. We will provide you with a Team Informational Packet at the first Team Meeting. Team Meetings are required and will focus on building team unity, learning about the culture of our designated country, discussion, and planning for our in-country service.

### ITINERARY (Tentative)

**September 17** (*Travel Day*): Depart San Antonio early; arrive in Guatemala around noon. Load onto the bus for a 3–4-hour bus ride to the mountain areas of Chichicastenango and settle into Casa Del Rey. Team orientation after arrival.

**September 18-20** (*Ministry Days*): Minister to different areas with dental, children/adult ministry, and widow home construction. This is a team effort between local Quiche leaders and OHC team.

**September 21** (*Rest Day*): Rest and enjoy Chichicastenango where we experience and enjoy a true "open air market day."

September 22 (Ministry Day): Village ministry (same as Sept. 18-20 above).

**September 23** (*Travel Day*): Depart Casa Del Rey and travel toward our departure city of Guatemala City. In route we will visit Lake Atitlan area and stay in Antigua for the night. We depart to Guatemala City early Sunday morning.

**September 24** (*Travel Day*): Depart Guatemala, fly home to San Antonio, arrive late evening.
